A tug of war rope is to be used; a marker will be tied to the rope marking the minimum distance from the tractor to the first competitor. The quickest time wins. Thick tops (or several layers) & trainers must be worn. Instruction will be given on the day. The judge's decision is final. Any unsafe behaviour will lead to disqualification of the team.
