

# **BLOCK THREE – YFC**



- Please note entries will <u>only</u> be accepted on the digital competition entry form, and must be submitted to the County Office by the set date.
- Clubs may enter the total number of entrants, please note that competitors over the age of 28 will not be able to compete at Eastern Area and National competitions and that only one entry will count towards points.
- 3. Provided a club has already submitted their current block entry, they may request to the Competitions & Training Committee (CAT) Chairman a late entry into competitions for that block. Acceptance of a late entry is <u>at the discretion of the CAT Chairman and Vice-chairman</u> and will not be permitted where this will detrimentally affect the running of the competition.
- 4. Change of entries will **NOT** be accepted later than 3 working days prior to a weekend competition, and 5 working days for a weekday/evening competition; changes on the day may lead to disqualification. Late withdrawals from any competition, changes on the day or lack of attendance will issue a £40.00 fine which will be invoiced to the club, this will be reduced to £20.00 if paid within 7 days. No show or Late Withdrawal from any competition will also result in 3 marks being deducted from the NFU Trophy score of the Club. Abuse, whether verbal or physical, towards any judge or steward will not be tolerated, teams will be disqualified if this happens.
- 5. All competition rules will be strictly enforced and if any Clubs are found to be in default after an event, their results will be discounted and any NFU Cup Points gained will be deducted. Clubs are asked to be particularly aware of the age qualifications for competitors in each

individual competition. These are clearly laid down in each set of both County and National rules. If you require clarification of any rules please refer to the CAT Chairman, Vice-Chairman or the YFC Office. National rules and guidelines will be in place for all National competitions.

- 6. COMPETITORS <u>MUST</u> BE REGISTERED MEMBERS. Members must produce a digital membership card with a photograph. Where a membership card cannot be shown digitally it must be printed. If no card is presented (either digital or printed) then the member will not be allowed to compete.
- 7. <u>Insurance</u>. The cover provided by the National YFC Insurance Scheme will apply to all Clubs and members participating in any of these competitions. Any queries regarding Insurance, contact the County Office in the first instance. Non-members competing where not agreed prior to the competition with the County Office will invalidate the competition's insurance for the entire day.
- 8. If, at the time of the competition day, a club holds an overdue invoice owed to Norfolk FYFC the club will not be able to compete until the invoice is paid in full. This is in line to the Constitution.
- 9. Selection of competitors for Eastern Area/National Competitions will be organised on competition days if possible.
- If there are not enough entries received for any individual competition, the competition will not take place.
- 11. A "SCRATCH TEAM" is permitted. The team cannot be placed but will gain I point for entering.

# **Estatewire**

#### RULES

#### **Competition Aim**

To provide an opportunity for members to demonstrate the acquired skill in building stock proof fence in a competitive environment.

#### Learning outcomes

A knowledge of planning and building of a stock proof fence using practical skills in fence erecting, budgeting for materials, acquiring materials, use of hand tools and teamwork.

REMINDER: Please read these rules in conjunction with **NFYFC General Rules** and familiarise all competitors with the **Fine System in place for withdrawal from competitions**.

#### 1. DATE & VENUE

1.1. After Area Finals, the National Final will be held at NFYFC Competitions Day on Saturday, 8<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

#### 2. **REPRESENTATION**

- 2.1. Counties may enter one team per 600 members or part thereof in Area Finals.
- 2.2. Areas will be represented in the final by one team per 3,000 members or part thereof. (Northern Area 2, Eastern Area 1, East Midlands Area 1, West Midlands Area 1, South West Area 2, South East Area 1 and Wales 2)

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1. A team shall consist of three (3) members 28 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022, and full members of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC.

#### 4. SUBSTITUTION

- 4.1. If two or more of the original team are unable to go forward to subsequent rounds, then the next highest placed team will represent the Area.
- 4.2. All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.

#### HEALTH & SAFETY – ESSENTIAL READING/ACTION FOR ALL COMPETITORS


It is essential that all competitors read the Health and Safety Executive's guidance paper concerning fencing and note is taken of the safe working practices and protective clothing equipment that is recommended. The Health and Safety Executive guidance paper 'Fencing' (AFAG104) can be downloaded from the NFYFC website.

#### 5. **PROCEDURE**

5.1. As agreed at the Competitions Meeting on Monday, 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022 it was agreed that for each round of the competition the two end strainer posts would be put into the ground prior to the competition by the organisers.

- 5.2. At the NFYFC Final the team will be required to erect a 22m stock proof boundary fence using the materials provided (as illustrated in the diagram).
  - 5.2.1. Total height to top of fence 1.15m (45").
  - 5.2.2. The intermediate posts shall be at equal spacing.
- 5.3. From the start point; the fence shall be in a straight line for 12m before turning approximately  $30^{\circ}$  to the right and continuing for a further 10m.
- 5.4. It shall be constructed of post and netting with 2 strands of high tensile steel wire above the netting.
  - 5.4.1. One strand of high tensile wire (ground wire) to be placed 50mm (2") off the floor.
  - 5.4.2. The netting shall be set 50mm (2") above the ground wire.
  - 5.4.3. There shall be 2 strands of high tensile plain wire above the netting, set at 50mm (2") & 125mm (5") above the top of the netting ie, 50mm (2") between the netting and lower wire, then 75mm (3") between the 2 wires.
  - 5.4.4. Netting shall be secured to the end strainers using a recognised knot.
- 5.5. At one end of the fence there will be a box strainer assembly using a horizontal strut and diagonal brace wire.
  - 5.5.1. The box strainer shall be made with 2 x 2.4m (8') strainers and a 2.4m (8') horizontal brace, with 2.5 HT plain wire.
  - 5.5.2. The horizontal brace shall be morticed into the strainers on both ends.
- 5.6. At the other end, the fence will be secured with a strainer assembly.
  - 5.6.1. The assembly shall be made using an 2.4m (8') strainer and 2.4m (8') angled strut, with the strut secured using a horizontal thrust block.
  - 5.6.2. The thrust block shall be dug 200mm (8") below ground level and be left open for judges inspection.
  - 5.6.3. 2 horizontal blocks on the bottom of the strainer.
  - 5.6.4. The strut is to be morticed into the strainer at 450mm (18") to the top of the strut ie, between the 4th and 5th wire on the net.
- 5.7. Where the fence turns  $30^\circ$ ; the turning post shall be a straining post without struts.
- 5.8. A hand tied joint will be required in the netting and a hand tied joint in the top line wire; towards the centre of the fence (no joining aids will be permitted).
- 5.9. A join in the netting must be made by hand where indicated on the diagram.
- 5.10. The team are required to prepare a written risk assessment/method statement, which is to be handed to the Chief Steward on the day of the competition - prior to the competition start. *Failure to provide a written risk assessment/method statement or failure to comply with it; or working unsafely, will result in immediate disqualification.* Please see NFYFC Fence Erecting Risk Assessment Template below. This may be used and completed as teams wish (Risk 1 already entered as an example).

#### Diagram is not to scale and is for illustrative purposes only All spacings to be determined by the competitors



- 5.11. Only materials supplied by the organisers are to be used for Area and National Finals (see list of materials below).
- 5.12. Only hand tools will be allowed and the teams themselves must provide these. No power tools or chainsaws are allowed.
  - 5.12.1. All tools and equipment used must be fit for purpose and be in good condition, well maintained and safely operated by members of the team at all times. Judges/stewards have the right to stop the use of tool/piece of equipment if, in their view, it is not safe to use or is being handled/used in an unsafe manner.
- 5.13. Competitors are not allowed to shorten any of the vertical posts.
- 5.14. The Judge reserves the right to inspect any strut following completion of the task.
- 5.15. All teams are required to dismantle their fence after the Presentation of Awards (The thrust plate and any

blocks/cross members must be out of the ground). – Teams are required to clear away all debris and any off-cuts of wire etc must <u>not</u> be put down the postholes. Receptacles will be provided for this purpose. Soil will be available to make the ground good. Any team not complying with this ruling will be disqualified and receive a £75 fine.
5.16. The Judge's decision is final.

#### 6. EQUIPMENT TO BE PROVIDED

4 x Strainers:	2.4m, 150mm – 150mm diameter round posts (8ft, 6" – 7")
1 x Angled Strut:	From 2.4m x 100-125mm diameter round post (8ft, 4 – 5")
1 x Horizontal Strut:	From 2.4m x 100-125mm diameter round post (8ft, 4 – 5")
2 x Intermediate posts	1.65m x 75mm - 100mm diameter round posts (5ft 6", 3"-4")
Thrust Plate and Cross Members	From 1.8m x 150mm x 75mm (6ft x 6"x 3" square)

25m x High Tensile stock netting HT8/80/15 Usually 8/80/22, but 15 will be used due to lack of 22 supply this year, even though 22 is recommended for this type of fence in British Standard 1722-2:2020. 75m x High Tensile plain wire 2.5mm gauge

150mm (6") Nails are to be used Staples

#### 7. TIMING

- 7.1. 2 hours 30 minutes will be allowed for the NFYFC final.
- 7.2. **Time penalties** teams will be encouraged to complete the task but will lose one (1) point for every minute or part thereof over the allocated time. At the NFYFC final teams will be asked to stop 30 minutes after the allocated time. i.e. at 3 hours.
- 7.3. Please note that the tidying of tools and equipment away will be included in the time to complete the task.



**NFYFC Tug of War Championships** 

(Ladies, Men's and Junior GENSB Competitions)

Following the Tug of War Association Competition Rules, 2011; incorporating TWIF Rules



RULES

#### **COMPETITION AIM**

To encourage YFC members to work together as a team to demonstrate their Tug-of-War skills in a competition environment.

#### LEARNING OUTCOMES

Tug-of-War skills: strength, rhythm, pulling position and technique; teamwork, respect, discipline, enjoyment, sportsmanship as well as providing health and wellbeing benefits.

For insurance purposes all rounds of competition must be held using a Tug of War Association (ToWA) judge and under the authority of a Tug of War Association permit (available from the Hon. Gen. Sec. of the ToWA). Further guidance can be obtained from the official Tug of War Association Handbook or ToWA website.

These rules are for the NFYFC final but may be adapted for county and area rounds with agreement from the chief judge. Counties and areas may wish to pull in a straight knockout competition or pull according to the pre 2011 ToWA rules.

REMINDER: Please read these rules in conjunction with **NFYFC General Rules** and familiarise all competitors with the **Fine System in place for withdrawal from competitions**.

#### 1. DATE & VENUE

1.1. After the area finals, the final will be held at Tenbury Show on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2023.

#### 2. **REPRESENTATION**

- 2.1. Counties may enter one team entry per 600 members or part thereof in Area Finals.
- 2.2. Areas will be represented by one County team per 3,000 members or part thereof in the Competition Final. (Northern Area 2, Eastern Area 1, East Midlands 1, West Midlands Area 1, South West Area 2, South East Area 1 and Wales 2)

#### 3. SUBSITIUTION PRIOR TO THE COMPETITON

3.1 All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1. <u>Ladies and Men's teams</u> shall consist of eight pulling members of the same gender. No more than **two (2)** members of a team may be between the ages of 15 and over, and under 17 years on 1 September 2022 and the remainder of the team <u>MUST</u> be between 17 years and over, and 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2022.

- 4.2. <u>A Junior GENSB team</u> shall consist of between 7 and 10 pulling members, male or female, who must be between 12 years & 17 years of age and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. This means competitors MUST have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 and may be 18 on the day of the competition.
- 4.3. All competitors must be full members of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC (You cannot compete for more than one club and county in one membership year). Competitors at the National Final must both present their YFC membership card and also, if over 18, have additional official photographic ID (Passport or Driving Licence).
- 4.4. **Coaches and Trainers** Only one Coach is permitted with each team during pulling. Only one Trainer or "Water-Carrier" is permitted with each team. During pulling the Trainer shall take up position well clear of both teams and is not permitted to address any remark to them during actual pulling. Neither the Coach nor Trainer need comply with other rules of eligibility.

#### 5. REPLACEMENT PULLERS

#### 5.1. All replacements must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.

#### 6. WEIGHING-IN PROCEDURE AND WEIGHT LIMITS

- 6.1. Teams will be notified of Weighing-in and report times prior to the NFYFC final.
- 6.2. The 8 members of the Ladies or Men's teams will be weighed as one and will not exceed:

#### Men - 680 kg Ladies - 560 kg

6.3. The members of the Junior GENSB team will be weighed as one with the initial weight limit of:

#### Junior GENSB - 560kg

#### An additional 10kg will be added to the weight allowance for each female in the team up to a maximum of 600kg

- 6.4. The competitors will be stamped or marked on a limb in a position easily seen by the Judge, but not easily erased by the rope or competitors clothing.
- 6.5. At weigh-in all team members must have their boots available for inspection by the judges.

#### 7. SUBSTITUTION ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION

- 7.1. After a team has pulled the first end of the first match, the team is able to use a substitution. A substitute may replace any one puller for the remainder of the competition (Age restriction of team still applies). Substitution may be used for tactical reasons or due to injury.
- 7.2. Any potential substitutes must (unless otherwise instructed by competition organisers) have been signed in and had their membership card checked prior to pulling in the competition.
- 7.3. At the time of substitution; both, the puller to be replaced and the substitute, must report in full pulling outfit, (shirts, shorts, stockings and footwear) to the Chief Judge/Chief Steward who may designate an official to deal with the substitutes. A small (bathroom type) scale must be available at the pulling area, (in a suitable place, on solid surface), to determine the weight difference between the two pullers. The substitute puller must be of equal weight or less than the puller he/she replaces. Directly after the change, the Chief Judge or designated official shall cancel the stamp or marking of the replaced puller, and indicate a similar marking on the substitute, with an indelible marker. This change shall then be recorded.

N.B For GENSB teams; Once weighed in, the team weight allowance cannot be improved upon through substitution i.e. increasing the number of females on the team. Any weight bonus must be removed accordingly if the number of females has decreased below the original bonus threshold of the team.

Eg. Team = 5 males & 4 females = 600kg (560kg + 40kg bonus). A female puller of 70kg is substituted for a male. The male must weigh 60kg or less (Both in full pulling gear) because the resultant bonus has decreased.

#### 8. DRAW AND BYES

8.1. The Chief Judge and Chief Steward will confirm the number of leagues teams shall be drawn into. However there shall be no more than 7 teams in one league.

#### 9. PULLING

- 9.1. Each team shall pull a match of 2 ends against every other team in the league with points awarded as follows:
  - 3 points to the winners in a straight pull (two straight pulls)
  - Nil points to the losers in a straight pull

1 point to each team winning 1 pull each

Note: If teams are drawing on points at the end of the league; they shall be ranked using the following system until differentiation:

- 1. Results of matches (between the teams drawing on points).
- 2. Matches won (most matches won).
- 3. Cautions (least number throughout pulling).
- 4. Team weight (lowest team weight at weigh in).
- 5. Coin toss or draw.
- 9.2. If there is one league; the top 4 teams on points shall enter the semi-final competition as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> v 4<sup>th</sup>; 2<sup>nd</sup> v 3<sup>rd</sup>
- 9.3. If there are two leagues; the top 2 teams on points from each league shall enter the semi-final competition as follows: League one winner v League two runner up League two winner v League one runner up
- 9.4. The losers of the semi-finals shall pull off for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> places before the winners of the semi-finals pull off for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places.
- 9.5. The semi-finals, 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> pull off and the final matches shall be won by two (2) pulls out of three (3).

#### 11 AWARDS

11.1 *Perpetual Shields* and Prize Cards to the winning teams.

11.2 Prize Cards to teams placed  $2^{nd}$  to  $4^{th}$ 

NFYFC Certificates will be awarded to all members of teams competing in the NFYFC finals.
