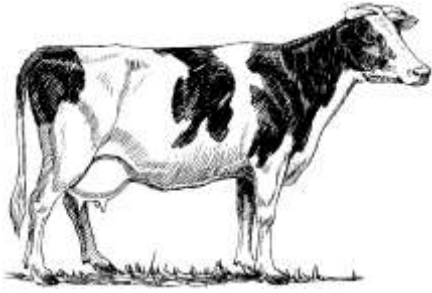

Dairy & Calf Handling Course

Want to learn more about Dairy Farming & Calf Handling?

Open to Norfolk Countrysiders aged 12+, the Dairy & Calf Handling course is happening at Grange Farm, Shipdham on the **15th February 2017!**

This one day course is only **£65** for Countrysider members and is a great opportunity to learn something new, especially if you love livestock.

During the course you'll get to address key health and safety points, gain a hands on experience including feeding and general care of dairy cows and calves, and a visit the parlour for milking (if possible), - so stick on some overalls, steel toe-capped boots and be prepared to get dirty! Steel toe-capped boots are preferable but not essential!

Places are limited at only 8 people per course - so book early, send in the tear off strip below with your payment to secure your place!

*You will be contacted approximately 4 weeks before the course date once your slip and payment have been received. Please let us know as soon as possible if you become unable attend so that we may offer your place to another member. If the course you are applying for is full, we will contact you and a second course may be arranged if there is enough interest.
